MERCHANT MARINE CIRCULAR MMC-175

To: Owners/Operators of Panamanian Vessels, Recognized Organizations, Masters, and Port State Control Authorities.

Subject: Crew Dispensation

Reference: Article VIII, International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers 78/95 (STCW 78/95).

1. Article VIII of the **International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers 78/95**, establishes that in circumstances of exceptional necessity, Administrations, may issue a crew dispensation; based on the analysis of the situation and provided that this does not cause any danger to persons, property or the environment.
2. The dispensations have been issued by the General Directorate of Seafarers; but taking into consideration that as of November 2007, the Segumar Panama office is providing a 24 hours service, seven days a week and created with the purpose of giving prompt response to the urgent requests of the Panamanian flagged vessels, effectively July 21, 2008, the crew dispensations will be granted by Segumar Panama office (24 hours service) and for any Segumar branch during week days (depending on their region).
3.
